The Challenge

Cambodia's General Department of Taxation (GDT), together with the General Department of Digital Economy (GDDE), has launched CamInvoice, the country's centralized electronic invoicing platform. Since its official launch on 12 May 2025, CamInvoice has followed a phased rollout — mandatory for designated government ministries (B2G) through 2025, with B2B expected to become mandatory for large taxpayers in 2026-27 and B2C to follow in 2027.

CamInvoice operates on a clearance model: invoice data must be submitted as structured UBL XML for validation against GDT rules, XML structure and e-KYB checks before the invoice is attested, hashed and stored on the CamDL blockchain and legally recognized. Approved invoices must carry a government-issued QR code for instant verification. Organizations running SAP need a standard, scalable path to compliance — without re-architecting their landscape or taking on custom-code risk.

How It Works

1

Create & Convert

Billing documents from SAP Finance and Sales (FI and SD) are consolidated and converted into e-documents under a single compliance framework.

2

Certify & Submit

The e-invoice is submitted to CamInvoice via API integration, which runs XML, UBL and GDT rule validation and returns a cleared, hashed invoice stored on CamDL.

3

Deliver & Verify

The taxpayer delivers the approved, QR-coded invoice to the recipient — automatically via the portal if registered, or directly if not; the QR code allows instant verification of the invoice details.

What the Mandate Covers

Centralized Clearance Model

Every invoice must be submitted to CamInvoice and validated by the GDT/GDDE before it is legally recognized, following XML, UBL and e-KYB checks.

Phased B2G, B2B & B2C Rollout

Mandatory for designated ministries (B2G) since 2025, with B2B expected to become mandatory for large taxpayers in 2026-27 and B2C to follow in 2027.

Blockchain Storage & QR Verification

Every cleared invoice is hashed and stored on the CamDL blockchain and carries a government-issued QR code for instant authenticity checks.
